Instructor Training Course:

Restructured the existing High Hopes PATH Intl. Approved Training Course to accommodate the changes within the instructor certification process for the September 2019 Instructor Training Course. Education can be taken separate from mentored teaching hours. Individual candidates may select to partake in the education only and/or they can participate in both the education and mentored teaching hours. This course began on Tuesday September 10th with three individuals who will be here to complete their education only and one who will be completing her education and mentored teaching hours.

All of these educational lectures are open to additional attendees in order to obtain their Continuing Education Hours (CEU's) for existing PATH Intl. certified instructors.
