Educational Webinars

Twenty three individuals purchased recorded and/or attended live webinars this quarter with a combined total of forty two webinars purchased. Two live webinars that were offered in December were "Say What?" and "Creating a Strategic Framework".

PATH Intl. On-site workshop and certification (OSWC)

This event was run as scheduled with six attendees from CT, NY, MD, VA, 1 for the workshop only and 5 for workshop and certification. Being able to have PATH Intl. faculty from Connecticut/ local to High Hopes allowed this event to be held as scheduled.

PATH Intl. Equine Specialist in Mental Health and Learning (ESMHL)

Was scheduled for November 20-23, 2020 and postponed to April 2021. This was largely due to the PATH Intl. Faculty needing to travel into Connecticut from a travel restricted "red" state and also then traveling back to their home state and needing to quarantine. In addition to the high volume of participants who would have been looking to travel from out of state.

Individuals Served:

To date this fiscal year Training & Education has served a total of 57 individuals of which 22 have attended more than one workshop and/or certification through 17 different offerings.

Instructor education and mentored teaching

Concluded our 10 days of instructor education in order to provide individuals with in person education as they work towards their CTRI certifications this September and into October. Our instructor educational offerings provide options for, education developed into modules that address the knowledge and experience required for the new CTRI JTA (Certified Therapeutic Riding Instructor Job Task Analysis) requirements for instructor candidates as well as ongoing continuing education required and needed for industry professionals. Additional we are continuing to look into how this course can be offered in a blended learning format for the future.
