

# Training and Education Report to the Board of Trustees

## Educational Webinars

Combined total of 110 webinars purchased to date this fiscal year. Two additional webinars occurred this quarter. These are a part of a four to five part series to cover cognitive and psychosocial disorders, which had previously been a workshop that was offered in person.

## PATH Intl. On-site workshop and certification (OSWC)

Final TRI certification event is scheduled for June of 2021. Three candidates scheduled to attend the certification portion.

## PATH Intl. Equine Specialist in Mental Health and Learning (ESMHL)

April 2021 had 20 attendees, which was our first larger event for Training and Education. The 'classroom' was set up in the indoor arena to allow for appropriate social distancing.

June 2021 is schedule to accommodate twenty attendees.

## Individuals Served:

This fiscal year Training & Education has served a total of 130 individuals of which 83 individuals have attended more than one workshop and/or certification through 45 different offerings.

- Two High Hopes education course offerings (14-16 days each) September- October 2020 and March 2021.
- Two ESMHLs- April and June 2021
- Three OSWCs- August, November 2020, and June 2021
- Eight Webinars offered Live or on-demand
- Mentored Teaching hours for TRI certification
- On-demand certification

## Instructor education and mentored teaching

Concluded working with one instructor in training for their 25 mentored teaching hour's onsite and one individual working on concluding their offsite and virtual mentorship.

## Reading Reins

High Hopes has sold and shipped out 13 books this fiscal year. This is a research-based equine literacy curriculum developed by Kate McCormick a Special Education Teacher, Literacy Coach, and previous Therapeutic Riding Instructor. This has been a great resource and tool for the EAS community as they too had to pivot a lot of their services provided.
